



NUCLEAR MUGA

Your doctor has scheduled you for a MUGA scan. This test will help assess the size and pumping ability of the ventricles in your heart.

Your one day study will be on _____ at _____.

On the day of your test, you will receive an intravenous injection of Pyrophosphate followed 30 minutes later by an intravenous injection of Tc-99m sodium pertechnetate. This will allow pictures to be taken of blood traveling through the chambers of your heart. The scan will allow a physician to determine the size and pumping ability of your heart. This scan will take approximately 30-60 minutes. There are no side effects from either injection.

Restrictions/Instructions: There are no restrictions for a MUGA scan. **Take your medications as directed unless told otherwise by your physician.**
